Internal scholarships are available to lower the tuition rates. See the school office for a scholarship application.

Victory Christian Academy is a North Carolina Opportunity Scholarship participating school. Due to recent legislative changes, all families living in North Carolina may qualify for this scholarship!

The reservation fee ensures your student has a guaranteed spot for the upcoming school year.

The enrollment fee includes registration, science labs, foreign language fees, fine arts participation, and annual achievement testing, as well as various clerical and record-keeping functions.

The resource fee includes books and resources.

The fundraiser fee is not required up front. In addition, we provide the opportunity to sell discount cards at the beginning of the school year to help families meet the requirement without having to pay out of pocket.

The enrollment and resource fees are included in the monthly payments. If a student withdraws prior to the end of the school year, these fees will become due in full. All fees are non-refundable.

A 10-month payment plan for tuition is available. The payments for this plan begin in August and end in May. Payments are due on the first of the month. If a payment is more than 15 days late, a \$25 fee will be assessed for each month the payment is late. If a payment is more than 30 days late, the student(s) may be withdrawn. If a student is financially withdrawn, his or her grades may be withheld, and school software access may be suspended until the account is made current. Payments that are more than 90 days past due may be turned over to a collections agency. The payment processing company charges a \$55 fee for all payment plans.
